Explanations

Memorabilia – The Agape Room has been converted into a Time Capsule! There are journals, notebooks, videos, photos, photo albums, slides, brochures, and so much more. Journey back in time to remember and reflect on Koinonia's past!

Hike to Floating Bridge from Conference Center – This 7/10th mile downhill hike is moderately strenuous. Please be sure to only attempt this if you are able.

Guided Hike across bridge to other side of lake – This 2.5 mile rugged hike will take us from the Floating bridge to the Dam bridge following the yellow dot trail, stopping at Chapel Rock and the Homestead Cabin. Lunch will be on the land – (sandwiches packed at breakfast so bring a day pack). We have three hours to complete the hike so a leisurely pace will be set, arriving at the Waterfront by 1 pm. The trail is very rocky requiring sturdy shoes. Tom will point out trees, plants and bird song along the way. Susan will discuss the American Bald Eagle in 3 parts: The Native Peoples, Coming back from extinction the 1st time, and the New York Success story.

Hiking:

*Lake Trail – This hike is rocky and moderately challenging. It will follow the lake to the beach.

*Meditation Trail – The Meditation trail is an easy path near the Kairos Conference Center offering access into the woods for those seeking a gentle walk. A bed of leaves cushions the ½ mile loop off the main trail. Simple benches provide a place to pause and posted scripture verses guide reflection.

Water Carnival – will include waterfront activities, games and races.

Auction – We have awesome items to bid on! Bring your mobile device to participate and support Koinonia's youth programming! Items on display all weekend in the Conference Center.
